Lighthouse Learning Center would like to offer an after school program for families at Edgecomb Eddy. If there is enough interest, the program would start September 2017. The program would offer the following:

- Hours: Dismissal-5:00 pm
- Rate: \$15 per day, \$20 on early release day, families are able to pick a schedule that best suits their needs, one, two, up to all five days.
- We will offer trips to the Boothbay YMCA for activities for families who are interested. I will pick up children at first dismissal and will return to Edgecomb Eddy when the last event is done (generally around 4:30 pm). Parents will be responsible for signing their children up for activities and any cost that may occur.
- Horseback lessons, at Burke's Island Farm, will be available for anyone who is interested and again we will provide transportation.
- We will offer a Robotic class one day a week and children will have free time to work with the robots during the week.
- Excellent ratios of staff to children to insure that children are well supervised. Program will be licensed by the Department of Health and Human Services and staff will have proper background checks.
- While at the after school program children will have the opportunity to play outside as well as indoor activities like crafts, games, Lego, etc.

We currently offer an after school program at Boothbay Region Elementary School. Check out our Facebook page (after school program albums) to see all that we offer. We would like to know if there is enough interest soon so we can let parents know if this is a program we can offer at Edgecomb Eddy in the fall.
