FIDGET SPINNERS - PLEASE READ

You know how you try to ignore something and hope it will eventually go away? Well, such is the case at school and on the bus with these so-called fidget spinners. Despite the marketing of these items as “therapeutic” or “helpful for children with ADHD,” we are observing a lot of misuse, and they appear to be more of a toy than a useful tool.



As a staff, we identify a few students who are in need of alternative seating, frequent movement breaks, 1:1 testing settings, fidgets, and other tools that are deemed to be supportive in allowing students to be successful. We also provide a few students with fidgets, although they are ones that do not make noise, and can be used more discretely than the spinners; we see this as our responsibility.

Our policy, as written in our school handbook, states that we ask children to not bring toys to school. We are, therefore, asking for your support in ensuring that your child leaves these fidget spinners at home. Or, as we say about other things like cell phones, if we don't see or hear them, no problem; children who bring them to school are asked to ensure they stay in their backpack when at school or on the bus.
